Mwamba is the quintessential African bush camp, featuring just 4 rustic rooms, authentically recreated each year using woven reed, thatch and other natural materials. Perched overlooking the meandering Mwamba riverbed, each chalet has a shaded veranda from which to enjoy the abundant birdlife and feeling of total serenity. This intimate camp is also home to Shenton Safaris most famous hide, The Last Waterhole hide, enjoying spectacular game viewing throughout the season.
